Our church remains open for people to pray privately in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. When visiting the church, please comply with social distancing regulations.

Fr Padraig is offering Mass each day for your intentions, for your deceased family members and for the safety and protection of all the families in our community. Prearranged Mass Intentions are being remembered at these Masses but families are also free to contact the Parochial House in order to reschedule intentions when the present health emergency is over.
