FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Sunday 1st December 2024



Advent is the period of time before Christmas during which Christians wait for the birth of Jesus. The word "advent" comes from a Latin word which means "coming" or "come into," as Jesus came into the world for us.

The circle of the **Advent Wreath**, which has no beginning or end, symbolises the eternity of God, the immortality of the soul, and the everlasting life we find in Jesus Christ. The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent, and one candle is lit each Sunday.



The First candle represents HOPE—because the prophets foretold the birth of Jesus and the people wait in anticipation of the coming Messiah.

The Second candle represents PEACE—Jesus's coming brings an end to all division and destruction, bringing peace on earth.

The Third candle (pink) represents JOY—as we get closer to the birth of Jesus, our joyful anticipation increases. The Fourth candle represents LOVE—the love of God for us that he would send His only Son into the world.
